## Add-on History

- Originally developed for NAV 3.7X
- Created to fill a need for Intercompany Processing, prior to Microsoft's Granule in NAV 5.X
- Carried forward due to client demand

## Differences

#### **ODT IC Functionality**

- Allows for coding each document line to different companies.
- Accommodates for GJ Journal IC and recurring journals.
- No Outbox/Inbox concept.
- "Auto Posting" flag to post pending transactions.
- Simple to use.

#### **NAV Standard IC Functionality**

- Allows for purchase/sale of inventory items.
- Outbox/Inbox allows for transactions across databases.



#### Overview

- Can control whether allowed in GJ, Sales and/or Purchase areas.
- Can define user allowed target account ranges
- Can select users to "Auto Post" on open of a company
- Can create IC GJ transactions including recurring batches.



#### Overview

- Intercompany Audit trail available and Navigate
- Works with Copy Document to repeat past transactions easily.
- Test reports display target dimensions and IC validation errors.
- Can (optionally) handle Multi-Currency conversion and post taxes.\*

<sup>\*</sup> Note there is specific exchange rate and process required to handle transactions between two companies with different currencies.
